Rules/Criteria

Participants must be k-12 students or teachers living in the United States.

Video entry must be more than 59 seconds and no more than 3.5 minutes.

Must include at least one on camera interview

Multiple entries are allowed

You must have permission to use all material in your video: video clips/music/images

- Proof of permission may be requested at any time

Submission Period: May 6 2011 – September 1 2011

Voting Period: September 2 -6

Videos with the most "love it" ratings will be sent to a panel judges chosen by the Radio Television and Digital News Foundation (RTDNF)

Awards will be announced Monday, September 12.

Tips:

Originality is Key: make your video stand out

Focus: Make sure your video has a central idea and stick to it.

Perspective: Although you are telling one general story, multiple perspectives can help bring the message together

Voting Period begins on September 2nd and ends September 6th at 11:59 p.m. CST.
